How to Complete Your Application DUE Sunday, December 18th

- 1. The official ASB 2023 commissioner application begins on page 3 of this document. Please make a copy of this document to begin typing in your responses.
- 2. Once you have a copy in your Google Drive, please title it: "(Full Name) 2023 ASB Application (grade number)"
 - a. Example: Jill Smith is currently a Freshman → title of doc: "Jill Smith 2023 ASB Application 9"

- 3. Then, please read carefully through the entire document to ensure you understand the expectations, values, and responsibilities of ASB. Consider the committee descriptions to see how you might fit into the ASB class and to further understand the functions of ASB.
- 4. **Agreements:** Fill in the required personal information directly into the document by deleting the existing lines. The Applicant Signature and Parent Signature requirements can be fulfilled by simply typing in your name and a parent/guardian name. As these "electronic signatures" will serve as real signatures and confirmation that you and your parent/guardian have read and consented to the agreements, it is our expectation that the appropriate people fill out this portion. As a prospective member of ASB, your honor and character are of utmost importance.
- 5. **Written Questions:** The last part of the application is the written questions. Type your responses directly underneath the question you are answering. Please do not have your responses be more than three pages in total.
- 6. **Submission**: Once your entire application is completed, please go to your share settings and change your preferences to "Anyone on the internet can view." Then, copy the shareable link provided and paste it into an email **TO**: asbwestview@gmail.com and **CC**: dsosnowski@powayusd.com. Please write your email **subject line as "(Name) 2023 ASB Application"**. Be sure to send this email by the **December 18th deadline!**
 - a. If this share process proves difficult for any reason, you may also download your application as a PDF and attach it to an email sent to the same addresses listed.

Interviews: January 3rd and 4th after-school

Tips for interviews:

- Always be on time Ensure that you're always properly planned for anything that could happen.
- **Be yourself** The worst thing you could do is to try to be something you aren't. So just be honest in how you present yourself. Please do not say what you think we want to hear. We need to get to know who you are and who you represent. Scripted typical leadership answers do not help us in the short amount of time we have to get to know you.
- **Be specific** Don't simply say "I want to improve school spirit." Come in with specific thoughts and ideas you think would benefit the school and why.
- Do your research Understand the general structure of the class and the positions available. You can read the descriptions in the packet below. Reach out to current ASB members (found at https://westviewasb.com/about) to inquire about their experiences. Be prepared.
